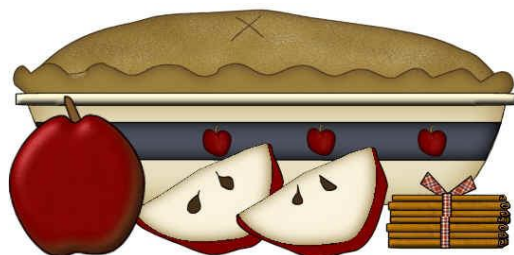


28th ANNUAL APPLE PIE FESTIVAL
