The popular “Quoi de Neuf?” Artisan Show and Sale is on the move to a new venue at the Club de Golf, Les Rochers Bleus Sutton. Formerly at the Knowlton Golf Club, and as always, the weekend after Thanksgiving, this October 16th and 17th will see the Quoi de Neuf? Artisans installed throughout two floors and five rooms of Les Rochers Bleus Sutton Golf Club at 550, Route 139 overlooking Sutton. Situated close to the popular Route des Vins and between Cowansville, Knowlton, and the Vermont Border, and overlooking the beautiful Sutton Mountain range, this show offers a great fall outing.

Open to the public for the past 16 years, The Quoi de Neuf? show has built up a very loyal following of patrons, and buyers. They come every year to view the wonderful, high quality crafts produced by the various artisans, and to place their custom orders, chat with the artisans, or to find that “extra special” something for their homes, or the special gift for someone on their list. Although show organizers are always careful to add several new artisans and crafts to the mix to keep it interesting, they are equally happy to welcome back many long standing artisans who people look forward to seeing every year. Started as a home show twenty years ago; the quality, boutique style atmosphere, and continuity are what makes this show so special.

This year's offering will include:

One of a kind, and sometimes life size Santas, traditional braided rugs, rustic wood and tin birdhouses, and mirrors, whimsical folk art wood carvings, rustic and wacky dolls, fanciful felted doll creations, stained glass, creative pieces and jewellery from recycled silver utensils, pressed flower and "papeterie d'art" creations, intricate art naïf cards, beautiful Japanese pottery, colourful ceramics, and blown/ flamed glass pieces, original quilts and cushions, incredible wood furniture and rocking chairs, wooden toys and furniture, intricate rod iron pieces, carved mirrors, and whimsical sculptures, recycled sweater quilts and doggy fashions, cozy angora fashions, whimsical felted hats, extremely original beaded jewellery pieces, leather accessories, fabric purses and totes, hand coloured silk scarves, and home made soaps, and bath mixes. Don't forget to taste the yummy food offerings: fudge, rose jellies, and jams, pickles, chutneys and local wine offerings.

New additions to the mix this year are: Wooden kitchen utensils, designer chocolates packaged for wonderful gifts, locally created, and eco friendly Sea Buckthorn skin products, and gourmet line, incredibly tasty baked goods, sterling silver, and semi precious stone jewellery, creative polymer clay pieces, and a line of coats, each one a beautiful art creation.

The new venue allows for even more artisans this year, approximately forty; and the artisans have generously offered pieces for a Raffle. The proceeds of the Raffle will benefit the Brome Lake and Sutton Food Banks.
